

Labels




➤ Labels () can be used to show things including:

- » Traffic Volumes
- » Number of Lanes
- » Centroid Numbers
- » SED/Land Use Data






The Labels Tab




- Select the field to use for labels
- 2. Set label placement options
 - » Note the "Allow Duplicates" checkbox
- 3. Set the label style options

The Overlaps Tab




- Overlapping labels can be allowed if desired
- Different layers can have different priorities
- Autoscale can turn labels on and off automatically

The Background Tab



Shadows, halos, frames, or shields can be added to labels to create better looking and more informative maps

The Callouts Tab



Set the default callout style to use when labels are manually repositioned

Practice 2: Add number of lanes labels

- Start with the results from Practice 1
 - ✓ Open the saved map if needed

- 3. On the top ribbon, click the labels icon ()
